
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
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
1. Overall View and Major Components

■ Main Body




■ Foot Control




*Elbow and drain pipe(VU40) are NOT INCLUDED with shipment. Please prepare it beforehand.

5. Installation Instruction

5-1. Preparations for Installations

1. Unpacking

Remove nails from lower part of wooden crate. Lift up the upper portion of wooden crate. Chair will be left on the skid.



2. Remove the pump cover.

1. Remove the screws and remove maintenance cover, base cover left and right from main body.

2. Remove the oil plug with red tag from oil reservoir.

3. Plug the unit power supply plug in to the suitable power supply outlet.

4. Turn on the main switch located on the left side $^{\text{Maintenance Cover}}$ of base.

5. Keep depressing seat lifting switch of foot control until the seat is lifted up to the end.

6. Turn off the main switch.

7. Unplug the unit power plug from power supply outlet.

Note: Do not remove the unit from the pallet until the unit fixing position is ready.

Oil Plug with Red Tag

Note: We use Phillips screws, so please use Phillips screwdriver for the installation work processes instead of Pozidriv screwdriver.

5-2. Installation of the Carriage Jig Holding the Carriage Jig and place it at planned location. Do not carry by holding the body or basin.

1. Fix the Jig A to the base. (M10 x 30)

2. Fix the Jig B bracket to the base. $(M10 \times 50)$


3. Attach the Jig B support bar to the Jig B bracket.

4. Attach the Jig B to the Jig B support bar and tighten the nuts. (M16)

Do not turn on power during installation.




Main Switch Foot Control

5-3. Marking for unit fixing position

Use supplied full scale template to mark the fixing position on the floor. Check the piping and power outlet position before marking.

- 1. Put the supplied template on the floor and hold with the tape etc. It should be set to the position of piping and power outlet.
- 2. The chair fixing position is marked on the floor.
- 3. Make it holes for marked position. ($0.3'' \times 2.0''$)
- 4. Remove the template from the floor.



5-4. Fix the Moistureproof sheet and gasket


Please obtain the moisture proof sheet and the moisture proof gasket to prevent from the main body damaged by the moisture. Deterioration and the breakdown of structural parts and electrical equipments might not be occurred without the installation.

1. Fix the moisture proof sheet on the floor.

Plywood Floor: Wood Screw


Concrete Floor: Glue

- 2. Make a cut in the moisture proof gasket according to piping position.
- 3. Peeled off the sheet on the adhesive face side of the moistureproof gasket. Passes under the piping and electric code on the moistureproof gasket and attach to the floor.
- 4. Seal a space around the piping and electric code.



5-5. Installation of unit


1. Remove the four tapping screw (M8 x 60mm) fixing the unit base plate to the pallet.



- 2. Hold the carriage jig and move the main unit to marked position on the floor.
- 3. Decide the installation position and remove the carriage jig A and B from main unit base.


CAUTION

Hold the Jig A and B to lift the unit by two workers to move it. Otherwise, breakage may result in.




Do not make scratch or damage the floor while moving the unit. Please use the carriage jig to move it.


- 4. Fix the main unit with the four screws.
 - Plywood Floor : Hex head tapping screw M8 x 65 $\,$
 - Concrete Floor: Anchor bolts M8 x 70
- 5. When the moistureproof gasket is bigger than main unit base, please cut it out.




Construction process of anchor bolts.




 Drill the anchor holes of a specific diameter and depth.



2.Clean each anchor hole thoroughly using a vacuum cleaner, with a narrow nozzle attachment to reach into the hole and remove all debris.



3.Insert the anchor bolt, tapping it lightly with a hammer to seat it. Position the material, and then drive the centre pin into the anchor unit it is snug.



4.Adjust the fastening strength of the nut using a wrench etc.


🗥 CAUTION

If the anchor bolt is tapped with its and contacting the bottom of the hole, the strength will be lowered. Proper clearance must exist between the end of the anchor bolt and the bottom of the hole.

5-6. Drain Pipe Connection

Elbow and drain pipe (VU40) are not included with shipment. Please prepare it beforehand.

1. Insert the elbow to the drain pipe from floor with seals.



The height of drain pipe should be less than 60mm.

CAUTION

Do not tear up the vinyl which is covered the drain hose.

- 2. Adjust the length of drain pipe(VU40), so that the one end of drain pipe(VU40) may become on the edge of the base, and connect to elbow with seals.
- 3. Connect the drain hose gasket to the drain pipe(VU40).
- 4. Through the drain hose clamp to the drain hose, and connect the drain hose to the drain hose gasket.
 - The drain hose shall be free of dent.
 - Attach the drain hose so as not to be folded.
- 5. Fasten the screw of the drain hose clamp for drain hose.
 - Tightening too hard may damage the drain hose.
 Do not tighten too hard.
- 6. Cover the elbow part with the vinyl.


Make sure all connection is surely fixed. please confirmed the water does not leak.


5-7. Water and Hot Water Supply Line Connection


- 1. Install the stop valve to each supply pipe.
- 2. Bend each flexible pipe to a suitable angle for connection.
- 3. Connect the each Check Valve to the each stop valve with the flexible pipe.



Check the each connection for leaks.








5-8. Unit Power Supply Line

1. Fix the plug on the end of the unit power supply cable. Plug the unit power supply plug into the suitable power supply outlet.

/!\ CAUTION

This appliance is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.




Power Supply Outlet


5-9. Installation of Base Cover

1. Remove the oil plug red tag from the oil reservoir. 2. Fix the base cover left & right with screws (M4 x10). Base Cover(R) / CAUTION The main switch does not enter by Base Cover(L) mistake when attaching the base cover. Oil Plug with Red Tag Oil Reservoir

3. Fix the centre base cover with screws and plastic washer $(M5 \times 20)$.



4 Fix the maintenance cover Attach the maintenance cover to the base cover left & right and fixed with screw $(M4 \times 10)$




5-10. Attach the backrest and seat cushion

2. Fix the seat cover L & R with screws.

- 1. Fix the seat cushion with six cap bolts $(M5\times15)$
- 3. Keep depressing backrest raising switch until the backrest frame is raised position.

4. Attach the backrest cushion to the backrest frame and fixed with screws (M6 x 20)



3. Seat Lifting Switch

Insert

5. The apron from seat cushion is inserted between the backrest cushion and the cylinder, then fixed with two screws (M4 x 18).

1.Seat Cushion

6. Raise the cylinder cover, attach the backrest cover to the backrest, and fix them with 6 screws $(M4 \times 18)$.




CAUTION

Make sure that the cylinder cover fits inside the backrest cover. Otherwise, the cover may be damaged.




CAUTION

Be careful not to hit other parts when attaching the upholstery and the cover. It may cause damage.




5-11. Attach the Neck Cushion

1. Attach the neck cushion on metal fittings as shown in figure.




2. Both side snap buttons of the neck cushion is fixed on a fixed pin.




5-12. Attach the Head Pillow


1. Attach the head pillow as shown in figure.




5-13. Attach the Hair Catcher and the Drain Cap

1. Put the hair catcher into the drain port and place the drain cap on the top as shown in the image.









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
