
Do not place objects of 10 N (1 kgf) or more on the side table. Doing so may deform or damage the product and cause it to fall over.



When securing the top panel, tighten the angle adjustment screw firmly.

Secure the top panel firmly. If the angle adjustment screw is not tightened securely, the top panel may rotate, causing an accident or injury.




### How to use

Moving the product

Move the top panel or frame by holding it with both hands.



- Reading a book
  - (1) Set the wagon in an easy-to-read position from the side of the salon chair.

(2) Place a book on the book holder and adjust the top panel to a comfortable reading angle using the angle adjustment screw.

Be careful not to get your fingers caught when rotating the top panel.


Angle adjustment screw /

• Storing the product

Multiple products can be stacked on top of each other.



(3) Turn the angle adjustment screw in the direction of the arrow as shown below to secure the top panel.





- When moving the wagon, make sure that there are no people or obstacles in its vicinity.
- Do not handle the wagon in a sudden or violent manner.
- Take care not to get your fingers caught when storing.

## Maintenance Method

- Wipe off any dirt as soon as it comes into contact with the product.
   Over time, dirt becomes increasingly difficult to remove and may cause discolouration or deterioration of the product.
- Wipe the product with a soft, dry cloth.
   If the product is heavily soiled, wipe it with a cloth moistened with diluted neutral detergent.
- Never use any of the following substances.
   Thinner, alcohol, acetone (nail-polish remover), petrol, paraffin or other volatile chemicals, abrasive wax, abrasive sponges, etc.
- Do not use brushes or scrubbing brushes.
   When cleaning metal parts and the counter, do not use brushes or scrubbers.
   Doing so may cause permanent scratches or cause dirt to adhere.
- If hair or other objects become entangled in a caster, remove them to prevent the caster from malfunctioning. When cleaning metal parts and the counter, do not use brushes or scrubbers.

#### Consumables

- The following parts are consumables and are expected to wear out, deteriorate, change in appearance, or be damaged as a result of use. Please note that their repair or replacement is not covered by the warranty and will be charged. (\* The degree and timing of wear, deterioration, and damage will vary depending on the environment and conditions in which the customer uses the product.) If parts are significantly worn, deteriorated or damaged, inspection or parts replacement may be necessary, so please contact your dealer or us directly as soon as possible.


## How to replace parts


- When replacing consumables, etc. with new ones, follow the procedure below.
- For replacement parts, please contact your local authorised Takara Belmont dealer.




- When replacing parts, make sure that there are no people or obstacles in the vicinity of the product.
- When replacing parts, perform the replacement on a soft cloth or similar surface.
- After replacing parts, check that they are firmly secured before use.

## ■ Replacing the top panel Please prepare a screwdriver.






Turn the screw on the opposite side anti-clockwise to remove it.




Pull the top panel section out of the frame (in the direction of A) and remove the screws holding the mounting hardware. Finally, remove the screws securing the book holder.

# ■ Replacing a caster


Please prepare a spanner (14 mm).



Place a blanket or something similar on the floor and lay the main unit on its side.



Align the spanner with the metal part of the caster and turn it anti-clockwise to remove the caster.



Insert a new caster and turn the metal part clockwise. Finally, use the spanner to tighten it firmly.
